All other gardens remain open throughout the winter.

Parking

Onsite parking is available on a first-come basis in the Garden's attached parking garage. Rates are a \$5.00 minimum, \$1.00 each additional half hour after 2 1/2 hours, with a maximum daily rate of \$10.00. Parking rates are not applicable for special events.

The University Circle area boasts more than one thousand parking spaces within one square mile of Cleveland Botanical Garden.

Accessibility

The Glasshouse and most of the grounds are ADA-compliant. Handicapped parking spaces are available in the garage. For your convenience, enter the Main Entrance on Wade Oval and follow the signs. Please note that Wheelchairs are not available.

Location and Driving Directions

Cleveland Botanical Garden is located in University Circle, directly across the street from the Cleveland Museum of Art and Cleveland Museum of Natural History. The Garden is three miles south of I-90 using the Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard exit (#177).
